From Pullman: Stay on Hwy 12 to Waitsburg, take 124 through Prescott and continue on 124 until the Lyons Ferry/Harvey Shaw exit. South on Harvey Shaw to Sudbury Rd (gravel road). Turn right on Sudbury, drive 6.4 mi to Olur Rd. Turn right and drive 0.8 mi, turn left at the 'T' and continue 0.6 mi to the plots on the west side of the road.

From Walla Walla: take Sudbury Rd and follow same directions as above.

Continue south from plots, turn left onto Thiel Rd and follow it to Sudbury Rd. Turn right, drive 3.5 mi to Loney Rd. Turn left, drive to Harvey Shaw Rd. Turn left and continue 6.5 mi to the plots on the right
