Tour starts at Denver Black's Farm:

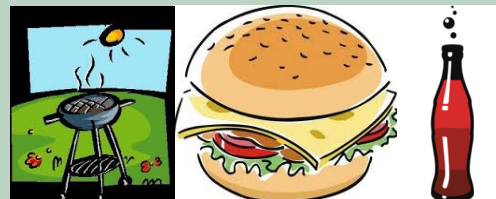
From Mansfield, head East on HWY 172 and go approx. 5.5 miles.
