Directions:

The tour begins at 4:00 p.m. at Schibel Farms southwest of Odessa.

From Odessa, take Hwy 28 west 7 miles to Kagele Rd. Turn left (south), drive 3 miles on the gravel road, and turn right (west) on Fink Rd.

From Lind, take Hwy 21 north 25 miles to E. Davis Rd. Turn left (west) and continue 7.5 miles to Kagele Rd. N. Turn right, drive one mile and turn left (west) on Fink Rd.

*****There will be a total of 4 field stops on the tour, with driving required between stops. The BBQ will be held at 908 N Kulm Rd after the last tour stop.**
